**16** As Jesus passed along the Sea of Galilee, he saw Simon and his brother Andrew casting a net into the sea—for they were fishermen. **17** And Jesus said to them, "Follow me and I will make you fishers of people." **18** And immediately they left their nets and followed him. **19** As he went a little farther, he saw James son of Zebedee and his brother John, who were in the boat mending the nets. **20** Immediately he called them; and they left their father Zebedee with the hired men, and followed him to Capernaum.

# Key Points

- Jesus was at the center of a large crowd in a place where he and his miracles were well known. (1,2a)
- He was preaching the word. (2b)

# Key Points

- Four men worked hard to bring a paralyzed man to Jesus (3,4)
- Jesus saw their faith. (5a)
- He told the paralyzed man that his sins are forgiven. (5b)



# Key Points

- The scribes reacted negatively (6,7)
- Jesus knew this (8)
- He drew a comparison between healing and forgiveness of sins. (9)

# Skip to the Ending

- Jesus told the man to walk. (11)
- The man walked. (12a)
- Everyone was amazed. (12b)
