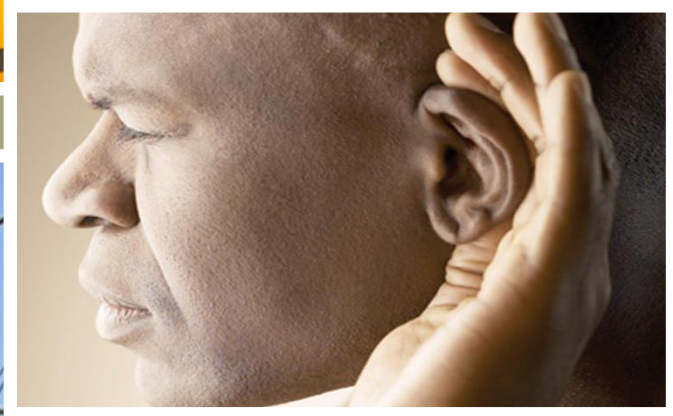
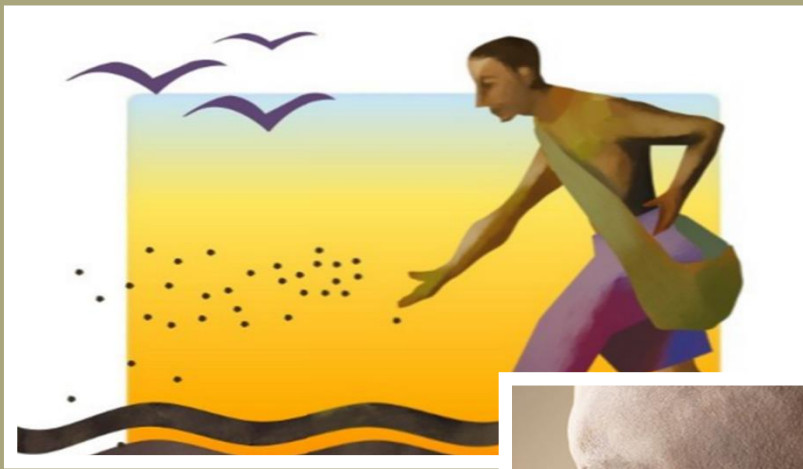
## The Gospel According to **MARK**

**1** The beginning of the good news<sup>a</sup> of Jesus Christ, the Son of God.<sup>b</sup>  
**2** As it is written in the prophet Isaiah,<sup>c</sup> "See, I am sending my messenger ahead of you,<sup>d</sup> to prepare your way; he will go out in the

**16** As Jesus passed along the Sea of Galilee, he saw Simon and his brother Andrew casting a net into the sea—for they were fishermen. **17** And Jesus said to them, "Follow me and I will make you fishers of people." **18** And immediately they left their nets and followed him. **19** As he went a little farther, he saw James son of Zebedee and his brother John, who were in the boat mending the nets. **20** Immediately he called them; and they left their father Zebedee with the hired men, and followed him to Capernaum.

Again he began to teach beside the sea. And a very large crowd gathered about him, so that he got into a boat and sat in it on the sea, and the whole crowd was beside the sea on the land. And he was teaching them many things in parables, and in his teaching he said to them: (4:1-2)

With many such parables he spoke the word to them, as they were able to hear it. He did not speak to them without a parable, but privately to his own disciples he explained everything. (4:33-34)
