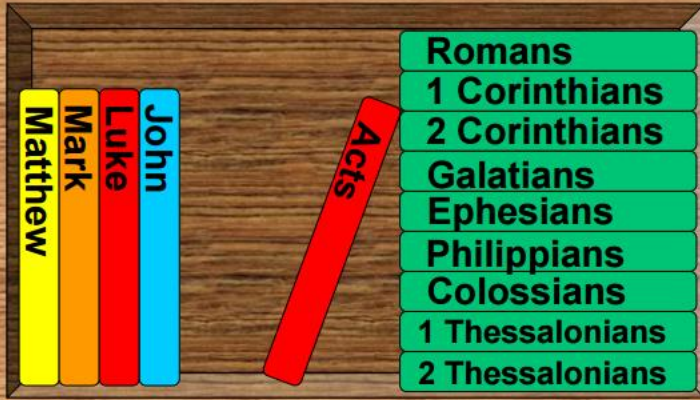


For all the promises of God find their

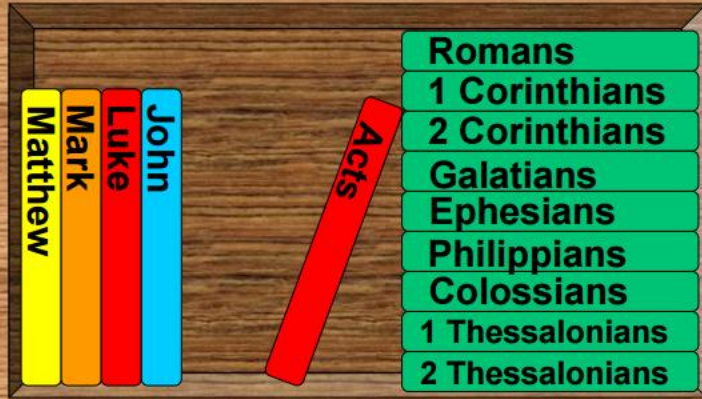
