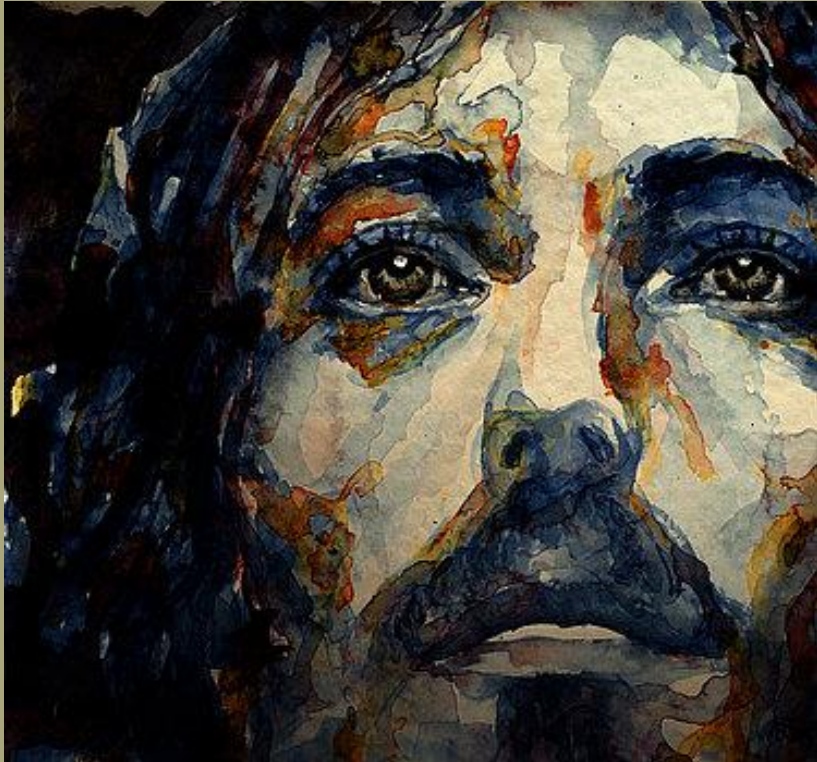

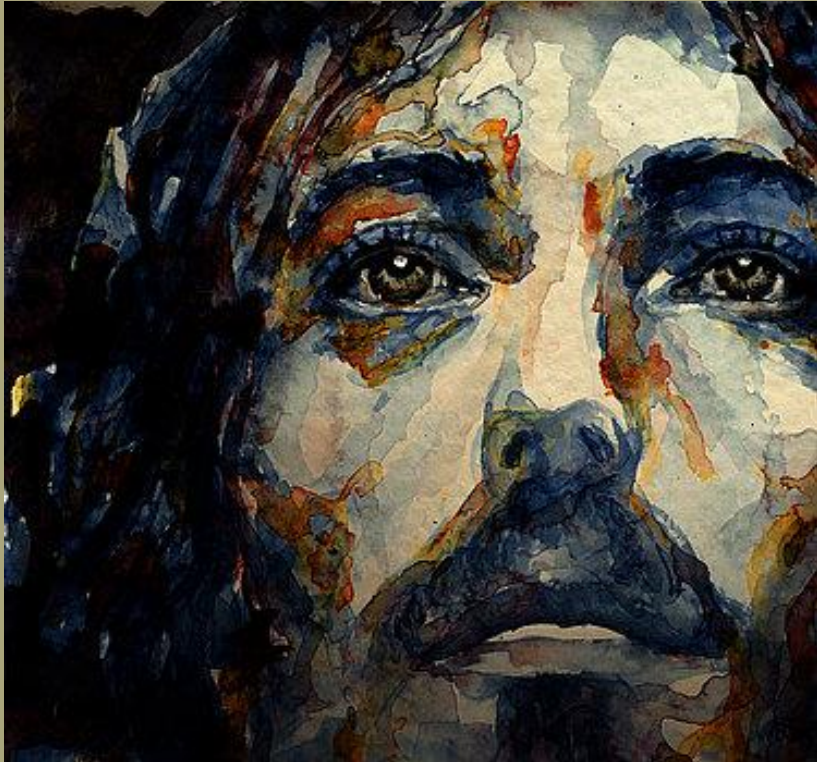
Much of his power is intentionally hidden, yet he attracts crowds.

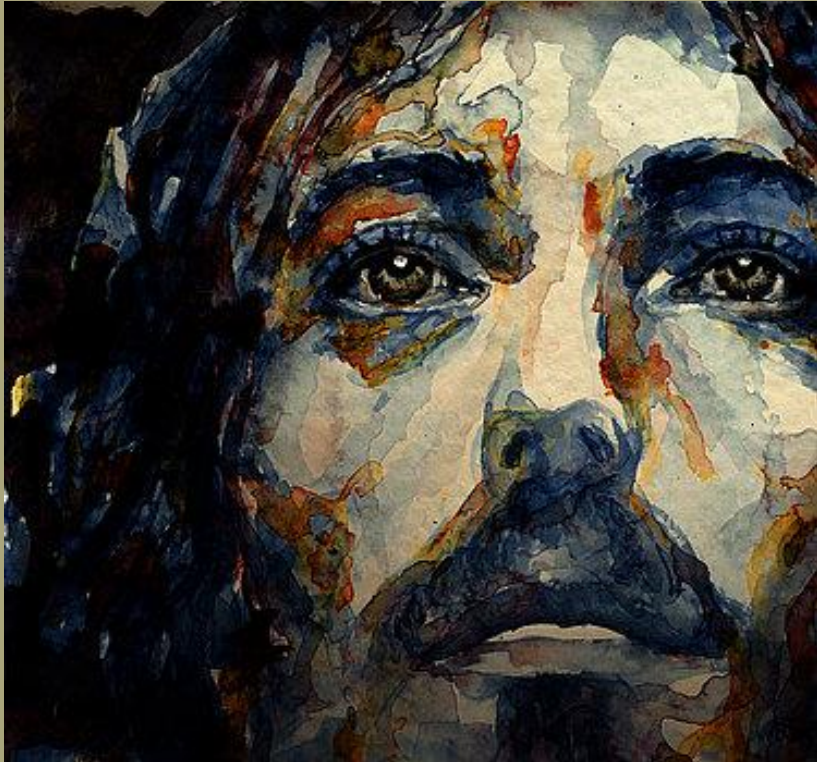
The powerful

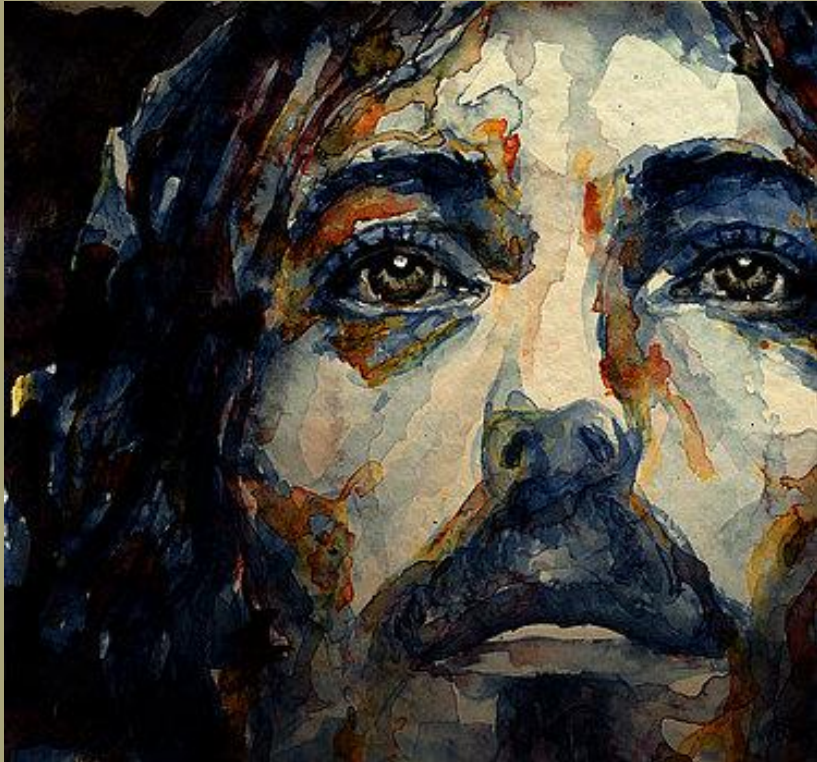
He stands on

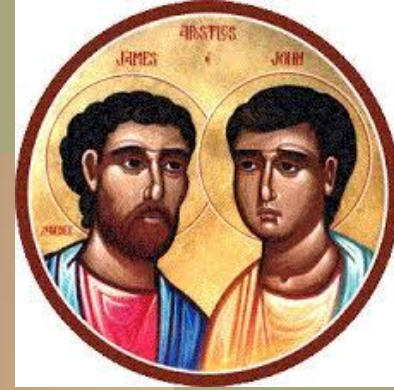
