Time Line

Old Testament:

Beginning → 5th Century BC

Adam → last of prophets (Malachi)

Everything until a remnant of Israel
returns from exile and rebuilds
the temple in Jerusalem

Time Line

Pentateuch (First 5 Books of OT):

Beginning → 1500 B.C.

Adam → Moses

Everything until just before Israel
Enters the Promised Land

Time Line

Leviticus:

All took place in a single month!

1st month of 2nd year following
exodus of Israel from Egypt.
(Exodus 40:17, Numbers 1:1)

Historical Narrative

Records of God's Commands, Laws,
Instructions, and other speech

Prophecy

Songs, Poetry, Wisdom, Parables,

Other

Leviticus

Consists primarily of records of certain commands, laws, and instructions spoken by God to Moses when the tabernacle stood at Sinai. (There are also narrative passages in Chapters 8 -10)

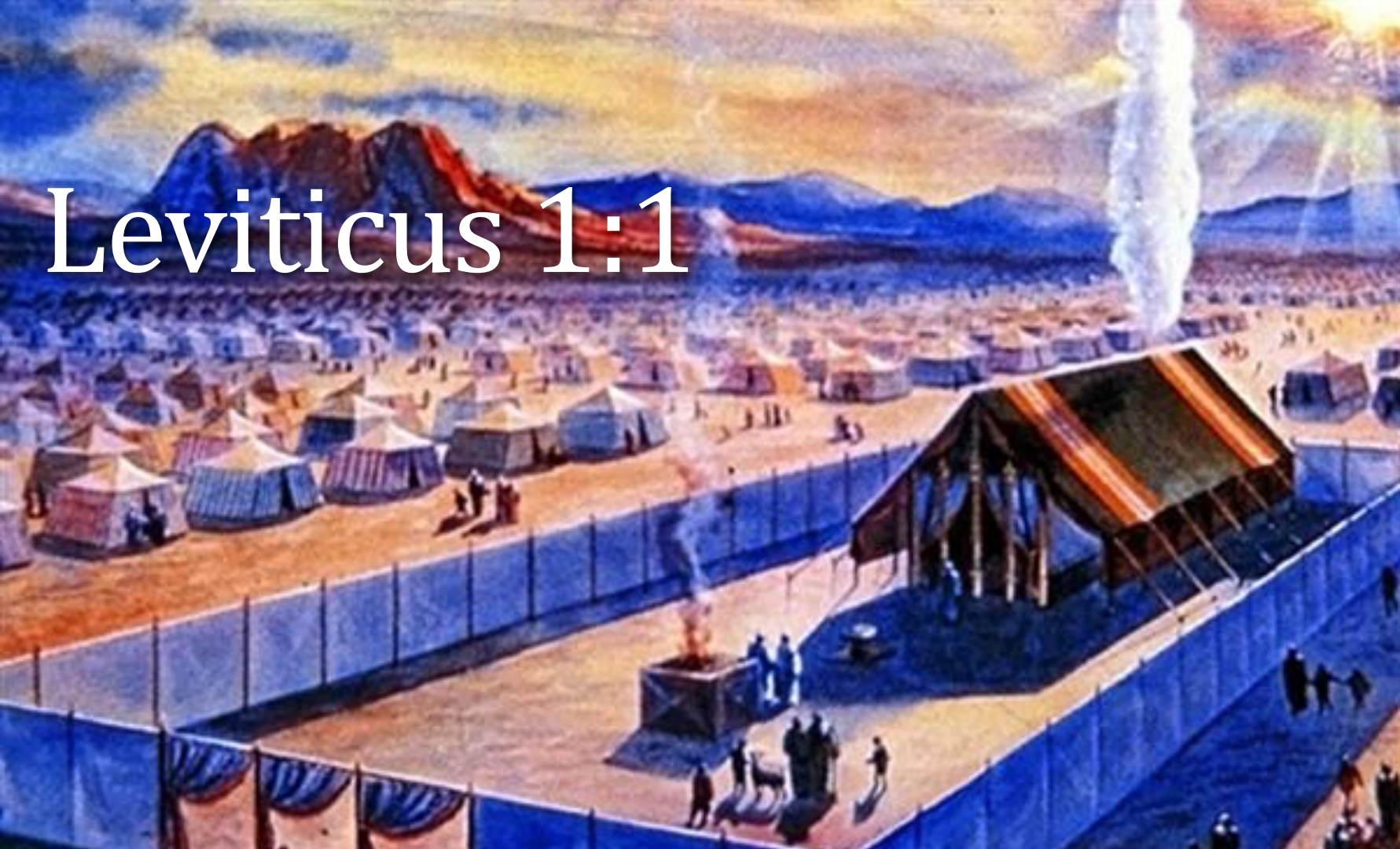

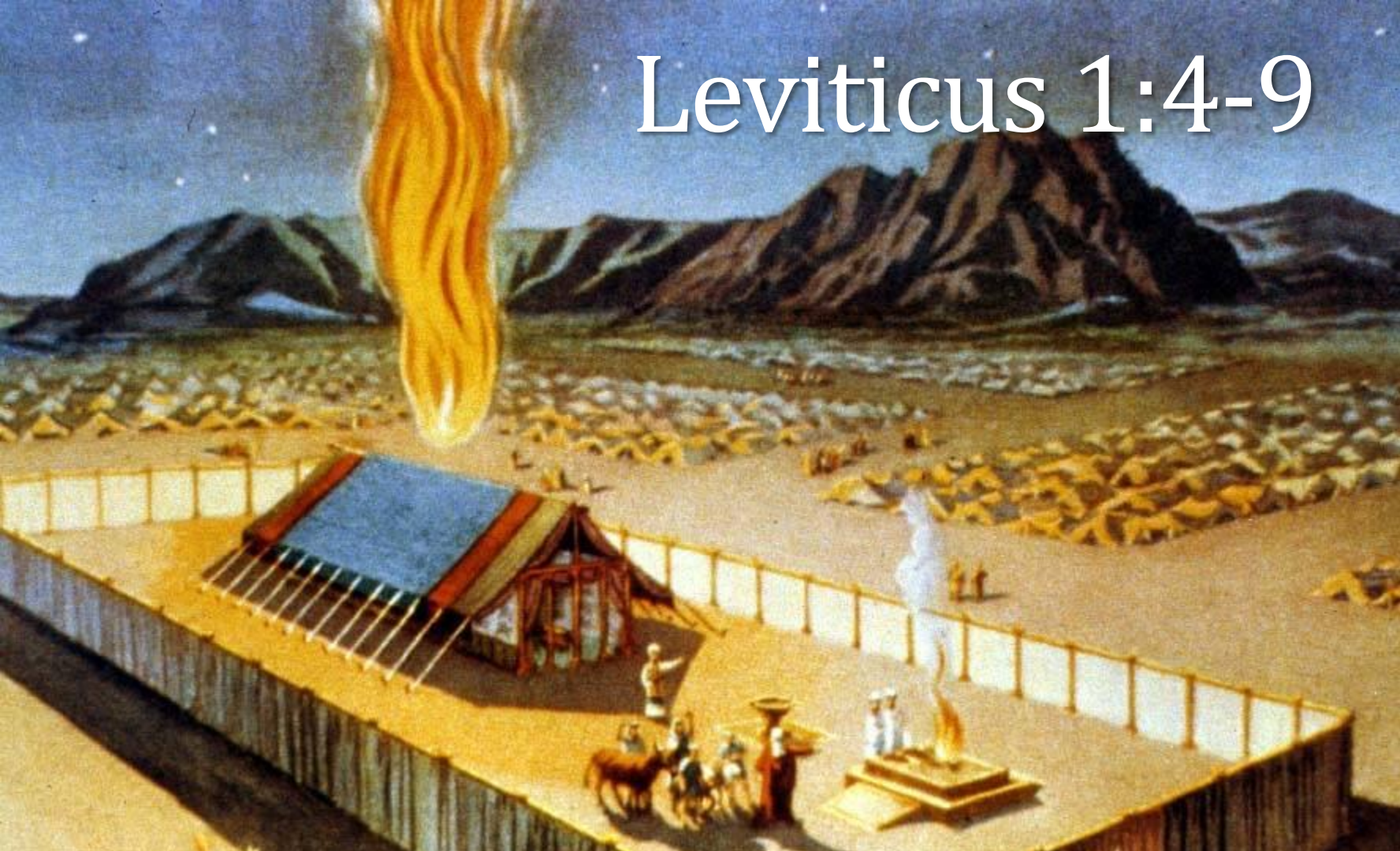
