# Leaven (Leviticus 2:11)

"No grain offering that you bring to the LORD shall be made with leaven, for you shall burn no leaven nor any honey as a food offering to the LORD.

# Leaven (Genesis 19:3b)

And he made them a feast and baked unleavened bread, and they ate.

# Leaven (Genesis 18:6)

And Abraham went quickly into the tent to Sarah and said, "Quick! Three seahs of fine flour! Knead it, and make cakes."

# Leaven (Exodus 12:8)

They shall eat the flesh that night, roasted on the fire; with unleavened bread and bitter herbs they shall eat it.

# Leaven (Matthew 13:33)

He told them another parable.  
"The kingdom of heaven is like  
leaven that a woman took and  
hid in three measures of flour,  
till it was all leavened."

# Leaven (Matthew 16:6)

Jesus said to them, "Watch and beware of the leaven of the Pharisees and Sadducees."



# Leaven (Matthew 16:12)

Then they understood that he did not tell them to beware of the leaven of bread, but of the teaching of the Pharisees and Sadducees.

# Leaven (1 Cor. 5:7)

Cleanse out the old leaven that you may be a new lump, as you really are unleavened. For Christ, our Passover lamb, has been sacrificed.

# Leaven (Conclusions)

1. Leaven is not bad
2. It is a powerful metaphor for things both good and bad
3. God's command in Leviticus 2 is a literal requirement.

# Leaven (Conclusions)

4. Use of unleavened bread for burnt offerings is evocative:
  - a. Passover
  - b. Communion with heaven
  - c. Spontaneity / Freshness

# Salt (Leviticus 2:13)

You shall season all your grain offerings with salt. You shall not let the salt of the covenant with your God be missing from your grain offering; with all your ...

# Chapter & Verse

Our current numbering system:

- Chapters – early 13<sup>th</sup> Century
- Verses – mid 16<sup>th</sup> Century
