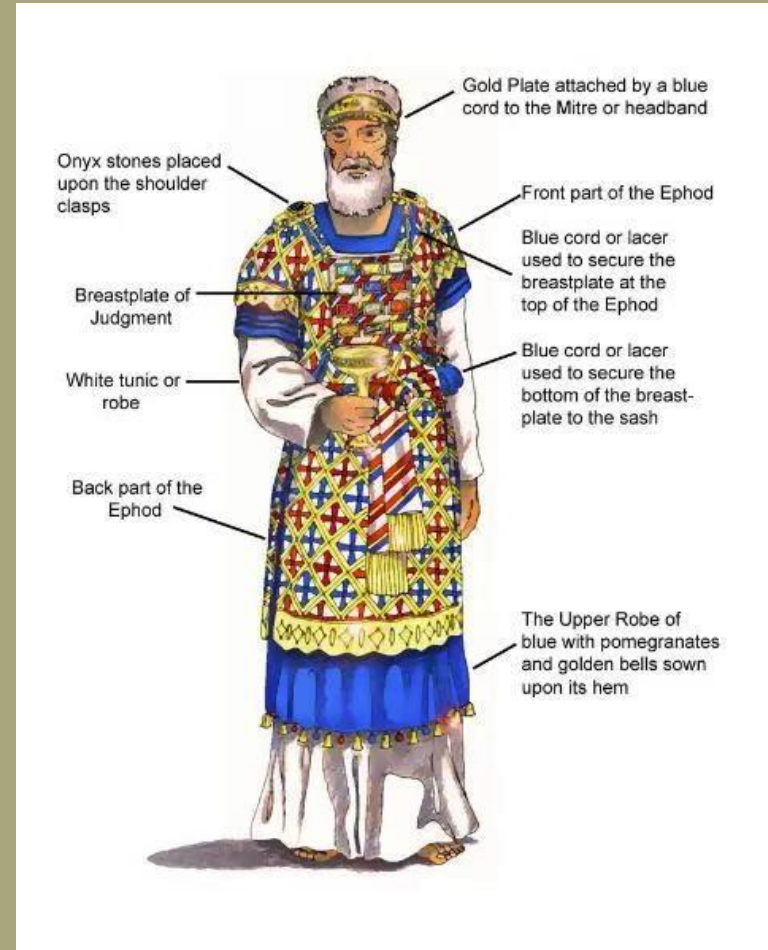

## Ordination by Moses of Aaron as High Priest and of Aaron's sons as priests in Israel.




# ordain

/ɔ: 'deɪn/ 

verb

1. make (someone) a priest or minister; confer holy orders on.  
"he was ordained a minister before entering Parliament"  
*synonyms:* confer holy orders on, appoint, induct, install, invest, anoint, consecrate;  
*archaic frock*  
"the Church of England voted to ordain women"
2. order (something) officially.  
"equal punishment was ordained for the two crimes"  
*synonyms:* decree, rule, order, command, enjoin, lay down, set down, establish, fix, enact,  
legislate, dictate, prescribe, pronounce  
"it was ordained that anyone hunting in the forest without permission was to pay a fine"

# priest

/pri:st/ 

*noun*

1. an ordained minister of the Catholic, Orthodox, or Anglican Church, authorized to perform certain rites and administer certain sacraments.

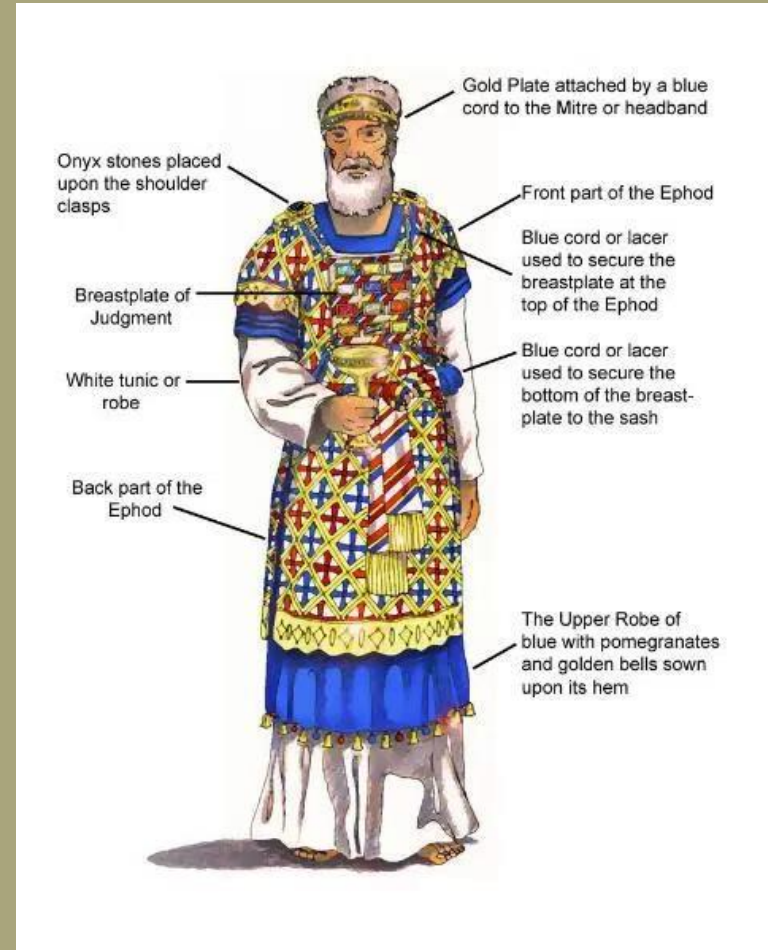
"the priest celebrated mass at a small altar off the north transept"

*synonyms:* clergyman, clergywoman, minister (of religion), cleric, ecclesiastic, pastor, parson, churchman, churchwoman, man/woman of the cloth, man/woman of God, father;
