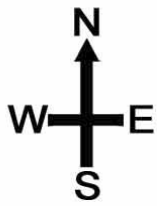

The LORD spoke to Moses after the death of the two sons of Aaron, when they drew near before the LORD and died,

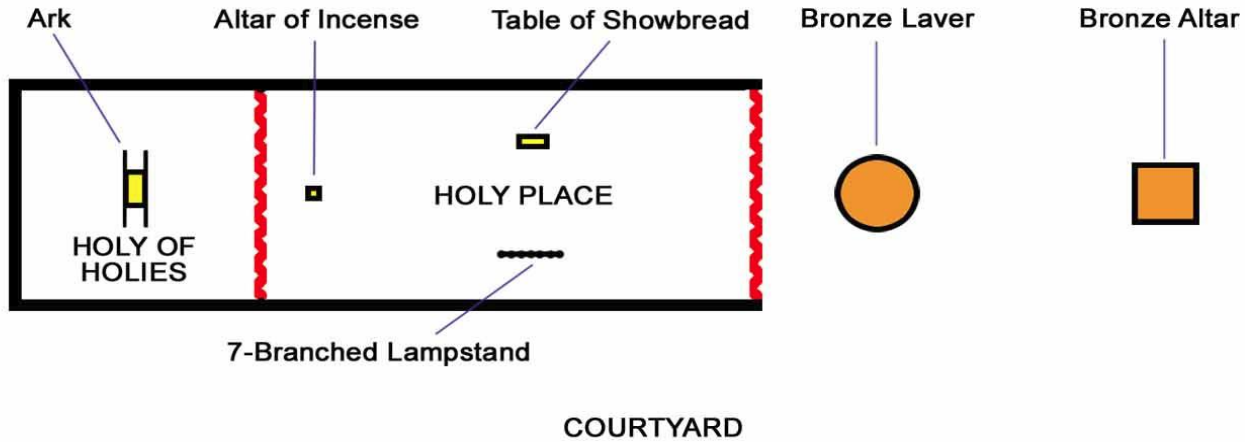
Leviticus 16:2
