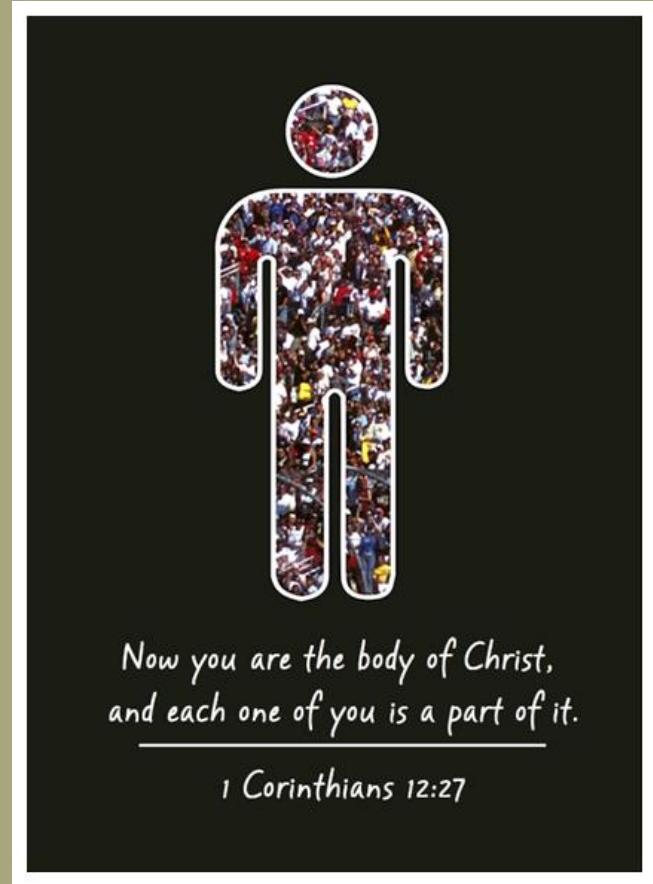

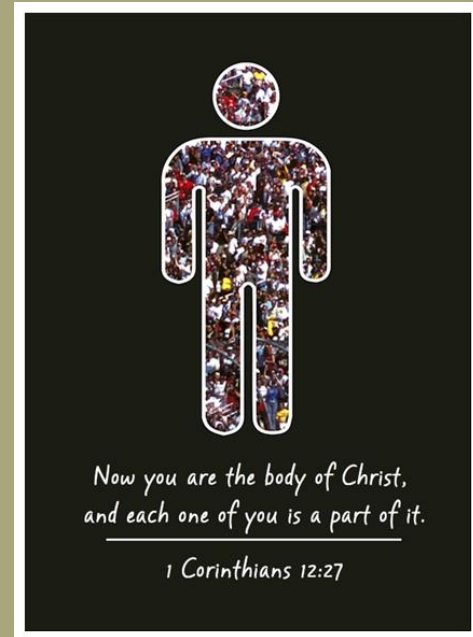

the sun go down on your anger,


