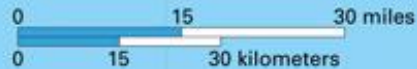
Luke 2:39

- **Bethlehem:** birthplace of Jesus, c. 4 B.C.
- **Nazareth:** boyhood home of Jesus
- **Bethsaida:** town visited by Jesus
- **Cana:** site of the wedding feast that Jesus attended
- **Capernaum:** near site of Sermon on the Mount
- **Tiberias:** Roman city on Sea of Galilee
- **Jerusalem:** capital where Jesus was executed, c. A.D. 29
