Therefore I tell you, her sins, which are many, are forgiven---for she loved much. But he who is forgiven little, loves little."

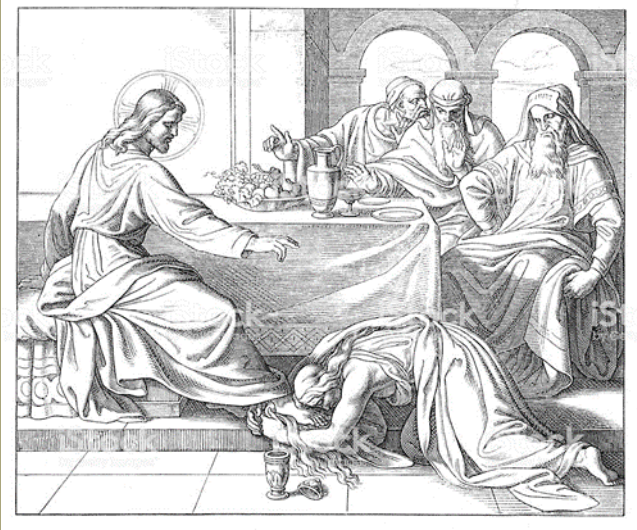

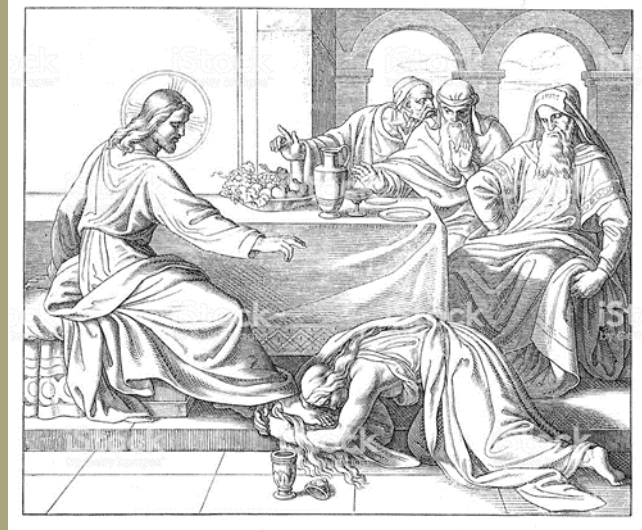
