# Luke 10:13

"Woe to you, Chorazin! Woe to you, Bethsaida! For if the mighty works done in you had been done in Tyre and Sidon, they would have repented long ago, sitting in sackcloth and ashes.

But it will be more bearable in the judgment for Tyre and Sidon than for you.

# Luke 10:21a

In that same hour he rejoiced in the Holy Spirit and said, "I thank you, Father, Lord of heaven and earth,

# Luke 10:21b

that you have hidden these things from the wise and understanding and revealed them to little children; yes, Father, for such was your gracious will.

# Luke 10:22

All things have been handed over to me by my Father, and no one knows who the Son is except the Father, or who the Father is except the Son and anyone to whom the Son chooses to reveal him."
