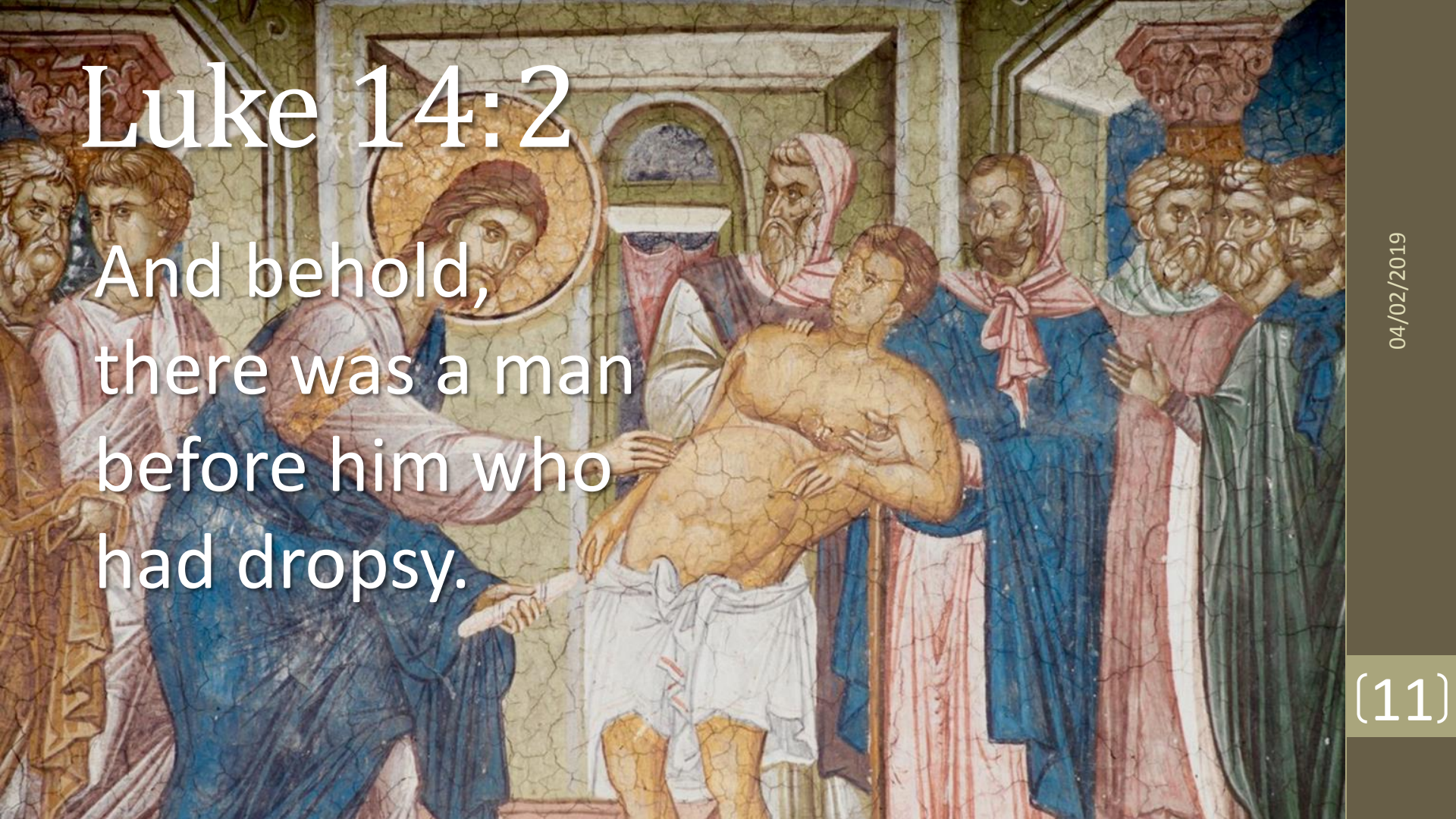
# Luke 14:1
