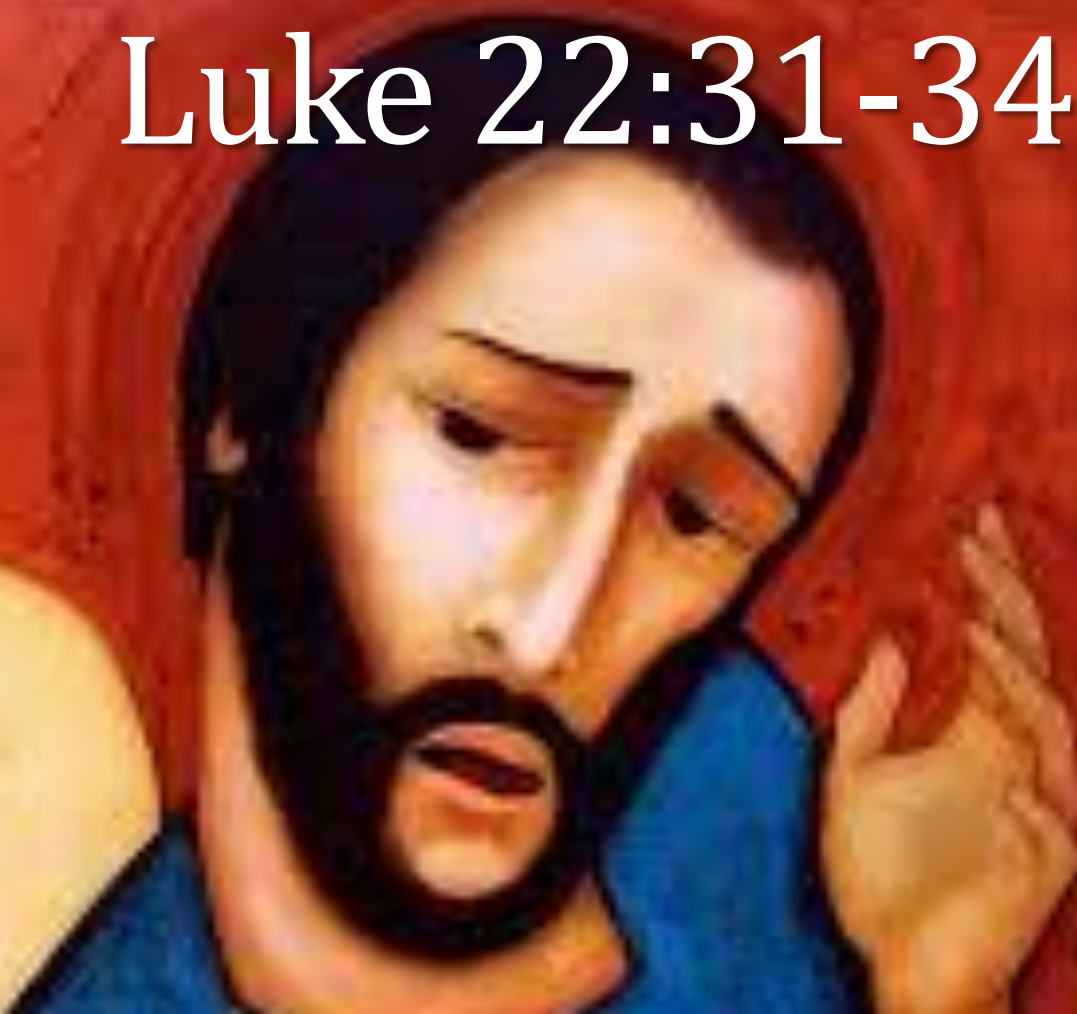

“Simon, Simon, behold, Satan demanded to have you, that he might sift you like wheat,
