# Luke 24:36

As they were talking about these things, Jesus himself stood among them, and said to them, "Peace to you!"



# Luke 24:37

But they were startled and  
frightened and thought they saw a  
spirit.

# Luke 24:38

And he said to them, "Why are you troubled, and why do doubts arise in your hearts?"

# Luke 24:39

See my hands and my feet, that it is I myself. Touch me, and see. For a spirit does not have flesh and bones as you see that I have."

# Luke 24:40

And when he had said this, he showed them his hands and his feet.

# Luke 24:41

And while they still disbelieved for joy and were marveling, he said to them, "Have you anything here to eat?"

# Luke 24:42

They gave him a piece of broiled fish,

# Luke 24:43

and he took it and ate before them.

# Luke 24:44a

Then he said to them, "These are my words that I spoke to you while I was still with you, ...



# Luke 24:44b

... that everything written about me in the Law of Moses and the Prophets and the Psalms must be fulfilled."

# Luke 24:45

Then he opened their minds to  
understand the Scriptures,

# Luke 24:46

and said to them, "Thus it is written, that the Christ should suffer and on the third day rise from the dead,

# Luke 24:47


and that repentance and forgiveness of sins should be proclaimed in his name to all nations, beginning from Jerusalem.

# Luke 24:48

You are witnesses of these things.

# Luke 24:49

And behold, I am sending the promise of my Father upon you. But stay in the city until you are clothed with power from on high."



Luke 24:50-53

# Luke 24:50

Then he led them out as far as Bethany, and lifting up his hands he blessed them.



# Luke 24:51

While he blessed them, he parted from them and was carried up into heaven.

# Luke 24:52

And they worshiped him and  
returned to Jerusalem with great  
joy,

# Luke 24:53

and were continually in the temple  
blessing God.
